Things NOT to Bring:

- routers (the College has Wi-Fi available in all rooms and common rooms – please note that it is against the College IT Policy to use routers and students will be subject to disciplinary procedures if they are found to be using one)
- any animals/pets including fish
- candles, bar or fan heaters, sandwich makers/toasters/kettles (They set off the fire detectors which as of February 2015 are installed in all students' rooms. The detector causes the College alarm to activate and a call-out automatically goes to the local Fire Brigade. The college is issued with a fine if the fire brigade is called to a false alarm – the fine will be passed on to the student responsible for the false alarm. In 2014, the fine was \$1,650)

There is a Kmart, Target, JB Hifi and Coles at the Broadway Shopping Centre which is a 5 minute drive or bus ride if you need to get anything when you arrive.
