## Payment Plans

Semester 1 invoices will be available from the portal in February 2017.

Semester 2 invoices will be available from the portal in June 2017.

*Fee invoices must be paid through the Student Portal using a debit or credit card. Other forms of payment are not available. The College does not accept cash or cheque payments.*

**Payment Plan A** - One full payment per semester

**Semester 1** payment due by **20 February 2017**

**Semester 2** payment due by **10 July 2017**

**Payment Plan B** - Two equal payments per semester

**Semester 1**

First payment due by **20 February 2017**

Second payment due by **8 May 2017**

**Semester 2**

First payment due by **10 July 2017**

Second payment due by **18 September 2017**

*Plan B incurs a \$325.00 extended payment fee per semester*

<sup>1</sup>Not refundable if the applicant receives an offer from University of Sydney but decides not to accept.

<sup>2</sup>As per the Residency Agreement, "Due Notice of Departure" means: (a) in the case of a student departing at the end of Semester 1, notice given on or before 30 April 2017, or (b) in the case of a student departing at the end of Semester 2, notice given on or before 31 October 2017.

<sup>3</sup>O-week is from Tuesday 28 February – Friday 3 March 2017. The O-Week charges are only applicable to undergraduate students starting in Semester 1 and do not apply to students commencing in Semester 2, nor to postgraduate students.

### **Late Payment Charges**

#### **Payment Plan A:**

- A Late Payment Charge of \$150 is applied if the whole Fee Invoice has not been paid by the Due Date.
- If you have not paid by the Due Date you will be automatically converted to Plan B and an amount of \$325 will be charged.

#### **Payment Plan B:**

- A Late Payment Charge of \$150 is applied if one-half of a Fee Invoice has not been paid by the First Instalment Date.
- A Late Payment Charge of \$150 is also applied if the whole Fee Invoice has not been paid by the Second Instalment date.
- If you have not paid one-half of your Fee Invoice by the First Instalment Date you will be in default of your Student Contract and the full amount owing will be immediately payable.
