Semester 2 fees are the same as for Semester 1, except that there is a charge for an extra 2 nights' accommodation, with the move-out date being on Monday 2 December 2019.*

Payment Plans A & B

Semester 1 invoices will be available from the portal in February 2019.

Fee invoices must be paid through the Student Portal using a debit or credit card. The College does not accept cash or cheque payments.

Please ensure you click on the "Redirect to St John's College Portal" link after payment has been processed.

¹As per the Student Contract, "Due Notice of Departure" means: (a) in the case of a student departing at the end of Semester 1, notice given on or before **30 April 2019**, or (b) in the case of a student departing at the end of Semester 2, notice given on or before **31 October 2019**.

²Fresher Welcome is from Tuesday 19 February to Friday 22 February 2019. The Fresher Welcome charges are applicable only to undergraduates starting in Semester 1 and do not apply to students commencing in Semester 2, or to postgraduate students.

Late Payment Charges

Payment Plan A:

- A Late Payment Charge of \$150 is applied if the whole Fee Invoice has not been paid by the Due Date.
- If you have not paid by the Due Date you will be automatically converted to Plan B and an amount of \$325 will be charged.

Payment Plan B:

- A Late Payment Charge of \$150 is applied if one-half of a Fee Invoice has not been paid by the First Instalment Date.
- A Late Payment Charge of \$150 is also applied if the whole Fee Invoice has not been paid by the Second Instalment date.
- If you have not paid one-half of your Fee Invoice by the First Instalment Date you will be in default of your Student Contract and the full amount owing will be immediately payable.

Change of Room Fee

- A \$125 change of room fee is payable if you change your room. A change of rooms is permitted only in the Winter Vacation with approval.
